Welcome to Morgan Bay

Morgan Bay is a lovely seaside village on the Wild Coast of the Eastern Cape province in South Africa. Morgan Bay is situated 90km (about 1 hours drive) north of East London on the R349 just off N2 toward Durban. Cape Morgan was named in 1822 after A.F. Morgan, who was master of the royal naval survey ship Barracouta. She was part of a number of ships on an expedition, under Captain W.F.W Owen R.N, sent out by the British Admiralty to survey the coast from Maputo southwards to the mouth of the Keiskamma River. Later became Morgan Bay or Morgs as its fondly known.

Flanked by a beautiful 2Km beach to the East of the village are high dunes which are perfect for sand boarding for the youngsters. The Ichara Lagoon wraps around the stunning campsite overlooking the beach which is paradise for kids of all ages. The shallows are perfect for the toddlers, while the rest of the water ways are used for canoe's and SUP's for the older kids. Either fishing or just having fun. At the end of the beach is the Cape Morgan lighthouse and the remains of the old Titanium mine which was abandoned in the mid-60s, leaving a tidal pool perched on the rocks.

Facing west you climb 70m up to the magnificent dolomite cliffs which takes to views you cannot describe, with paths that meander the length of the cliffs taking you back down to the Double Mouth nature reserve, the viewpoints along the way are widely used as look out points for the Dolphin and the Whales during the Sardine run which occurs between May and late July.

Local Safety Initiatives Boost Safety in Kei Mouth

Kei Mouth and Morgan Bay are fortunate enough to enjoy better resources than some of our neighbours on the other side of the Kei River. We have fairly reliable cellphone coverage throughout the area, good roads, and a robust police force backed by a strong Community Police Forum and non-profit community safety organisation.

Our local safety organisation, the **Kei Watch Action Group (KWAG)**, has over 200 members and a committee that meets monthly to address security concerns and spearhead community solutions. They have a network of over 80 radios that are used to communicate any suspicious activity and coordinate rapid responses to potential threats.

This system allows for real-time information sharing and enables community members to quickly alert each other and local law enforcement about any potential disturbances to village life, even when cellphone coverage is unavailable.

There is also a **network of cameras** throughout the village and outlying areas, which provide 24/7 surveillance and act as a deterrent to potential criminals. These cameras are monitored regularly and can provide crucial evidence in the event of any criminal activity.

These monitoring efforts are further supported by the license plate recognition camera situated between Kei Mouth and Morgan Bay, which helps track vehicle movements in and out of the area, providing an additional layer of security.



Local security firm, **Komga Alarms**, also conducts regular patrols around the village, while NSRI lifeguards are on hand to provide support on the beaches, keeping visitors safe from crime, as well as currents. They are also equipped with radios that enable them to contact law enforcement and community members for support should an incident arise.

Rip Current Safety

Know **BEFORE** you enter the water what rip currents are, and how to escape them

Rip currents are channelized currents of water flowing away from shore at surf beaches. Typically, they form at breaks in sandbars, and also near structures, such as jetties and piers, as well as cliffs that jut into the water. Rip currents are common and can be found on most surf beaches.

Activities to do & Places to go

Kei Mouth's Beaches

Kei Mouth has several small sandy beaches dotted along the shoreline. The best beach for swimming is the middle of Thompson's Bay. Swimming in the mouth of the Great Kei River is not recommended, due to the strong river currents.



Morgan Bay Beach

The flat, 1.6km long sandy beach is great for ball games like cricket, rugby and tennis. A touch rugby and cricket tournament is held once a year between Christmas and New Year. The dunes are good for sandboarding and our beach is also ideal for jogging and walking. Other activities include swimming, fishing, kite flying, body boarding, sandcastle building and horse riding. Sandboards and bodyboards can be hired from Morgan Bay Hotel Reception.



Cattle on the Beaches

One of the characteristic features of the Wild Coast, is cattle on the beaches. Even though there is no grass or drinking water, they still love coming down to the beach to sleep, relax and chew the cud. There are a couple of theories as to why they do this; Some say it's to rid themselves of ticks, while others claim they are after salt. Perhaps it's simpler than that... maybe they just enjoy it as much as we do. They are often found on both banks of the Great Kei River, between the ferry and the sea as well as on the beach at Qolora.



The Kei Mouth Ferry/Pont

Intro

We began ferrying vehicles and passengers across the river at Kei Mouth in 1990, providing a vital link between Kei Mouth and the Wild Coast.

The Pont operates 7 days a week, 365 days a year. they only close when the river is in flood or the tide is too low. The Pont can carry two vehicles at a time and operates from 7h00 to 18h00. There are often long queues during the height of the Dec/Jan holidays, so factor this into your journey. Daily updates can be found on our Facebook page, Kei Mouth Ferry.

The Great Kei River

The Great Kei River flows for 320 km and once formed the South-Western border of the former-Transkei region, which can now be accessed via the 'Pont', one of only three car-transporting river ferries in South Africa. Activities on the river include fishing, boating, and canoeing. South Africa's Southern-most naturally occurring mangrove population also occurs here.

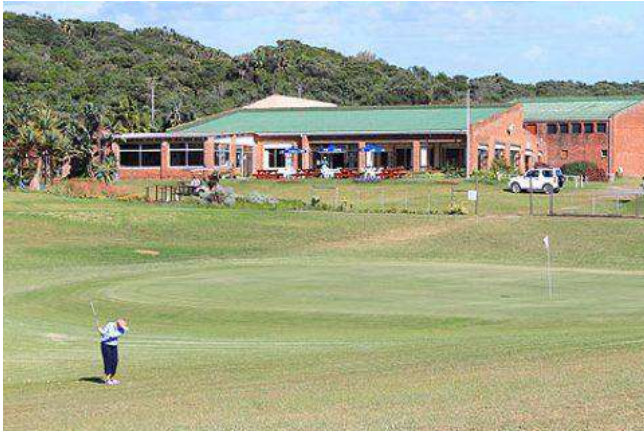

Double Mouth Nature Reserve

This pristine coastal nature reserve boasts one of SA's most picturesque campsites and lies only 4km away from Morgan Bay over the cliffs. Here two rivers meet in a pristine estuary, which carves a single course through forested dunes to the sea. Bead Beach (Treasure Beach) is the site of a 17th Century Portuguese shipwreck, where Carnelian Beads, Money Cowries and shards of broken Ming Porcelain can be found. Motorbikes, Quads and dogs are not permitted.

Entry is R44 per adult and R28 per child (2 – 11 years).

Fishing

The Southern Wild Coast offers a great variety of desirable species in some spectacular fishing locations. If you need advice about where to fish, and what with, then contact a guide, like Great Kei Adventures and Wild Coast Fishing Charters, or ask our friendly locals. Deep Sea enthusiasts can launch from the Great Kei River, while fishing and bait collection licenses can be purchased at most Post Offices and at St Anthony's Store on the R349 at the Haga Haga turnoff.



Walks and Trails

There are many great walks to be had along our beaches, as well as several other trails for the more adventurous. These include: the walk up to the lookout platforms on Signal Hill and back again via Lover's Lane; a walk along the coastline to the lighthouse and on to neighbouring Morgan Bay; walks along the beautiful sandy beaches North of the Kei.



Signal Hill and Lover's Lane

Directly across the road from the library, in the main road, is a path that leads up through the coastal forest on Signal Hill and past three lookout points with excellent views of the village, ocean and river mouth. It then leads steeply downhill to the river, where you can enjoy a brisk walk along the beach. From there, head back through the forest along Lover's Lane, past Kei Sands and turn right, back to the main road where you started.

The walk is only 1.5km long (excl. your beach detour) but you need to be quite fit as the hill is fairly steep on the way up and steeper on the way down.



Activities to do & Places to go

The Cape Morgan Lighthouse / Morgan Bay

Follow the road that winds South West along the seafront from Whispering Waves, into the Cape Morgan Nature Reserve and all the way to the Cape Morgan Lighthouse. From here, a path leads into the forest and descends to a tidal pool where an old pump house used to pump sea water up into the dunes, to the workings of the now defunct Titanium mine.

If you're still feeling fit, then head further West along the coastline and along the mile-long beach to Morgan Bay. Stop for refreshments at one of the eateries in town and then head back the way you came.

NB: An alternative route back from the tidal pool takes you along rocky fishermen's trails, back to the point where the road from Whispering Waves enters the coastal forest



Across the Great Kei

A short trip across the Great Kei river on the Pont, transports you to some of the most deserted beaches South Africa has to offer. A 2.5km walk along the coastline takes you to the picturesque mouth of the Gxara river where you can cool off in the estuary and have a picnic. Another 4.5kms distant is the small seaside hamlet of Qolora where you can stop for lunch at either the Seagulls or Trennerys Hotels. There is another picturesque estuary there and a nearly 2km long beach for you to enjoy.



Strandloper Trail

Kei Mouth is the start of the popular five day Strandloper Trail, which begins in the Cape Morgan Nature Reserve and passes through Morgan Bay, Haga Haga and the Jikeleza Route villages before finishing at Gonubie.

The Morgan Bay Cliffs

Pack your camera and go for a hike over the spectacular cliffs. These impressive slabs of dolerite, which drop some 50 meters into the pounding surf, are ideal vantage points for watching the sunrise or enjoying a sundowner with friends. If you're lucky, you may even see the dolphins frolicking in the waves which crash against the rocks below.



Trevor's Trails

Gates trail: A short boat ride and an easy educational walk in the sub-tropical forest brings you to an amazing rock formation called "The Gates". Bring your costume, as there is a great waterfall to swim under. The return walk, over higher ground, offers great views. +- 3hours, max 20 people.

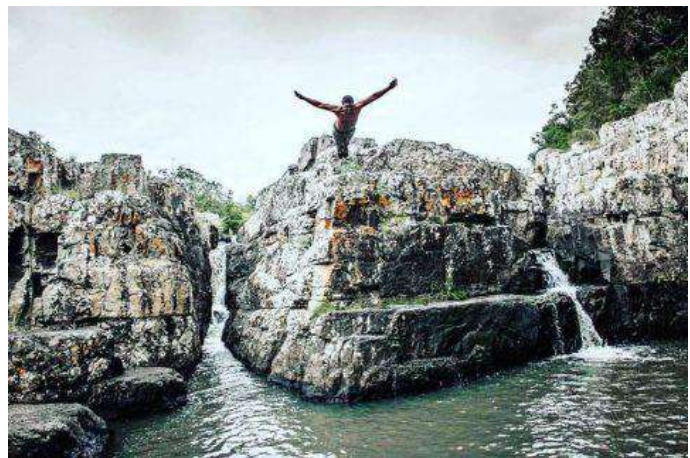
Sundown Cruise: Motor slowly up the Qolora River and enjoy the rich bird life. Bring your costume, camera, hats and liquid refreshments. +- 2 hours, max 15 people.

Culture Trail: Enjoy singing, traditional dancing and the preparation and tasting of traditional food, followed by an informal chat with a traditional healer. Please book 1 day in advance. +- 2 hours, min 7 people/ max 30 people.

4x4 Trail: Trevor will pick you up in his 4x4 and take you to visit a Khoisan Midden at Halls Point, followed by a drive to the spectacular falls on the Gxara River. +- 2 hours, max 9 people.

Haga Haga Hiking Trails

Whale Point Walk: A scenic walk to the top of Whale Point, which can be extended by following the path over the brow of the hill and down to Flanagan's Bay, before circling back along the coastline to Haga Haga.

Krantz Garden Walk: An easy-going walk along the coastal paths between Haga Haga and Pullen's Bay. Plan your walk to coincide with low tide in each direction.

Otter Creek Trail: Beginning in Hadedu Way, this inland route follows the creek through indigenous forest up to the Old Ninky Noo's Pub.

Lagoon View Walk: A pleasant walk along the hillside behind the club, interspersed with benches at strategic points, where the views are great.

Haga Haga Retreat River Trail: This 3km amble starts just inside the gates of the Haga Haga Retreat development and meanders alongside the river through the pristine riverine forest, before looping back along the road to the start.

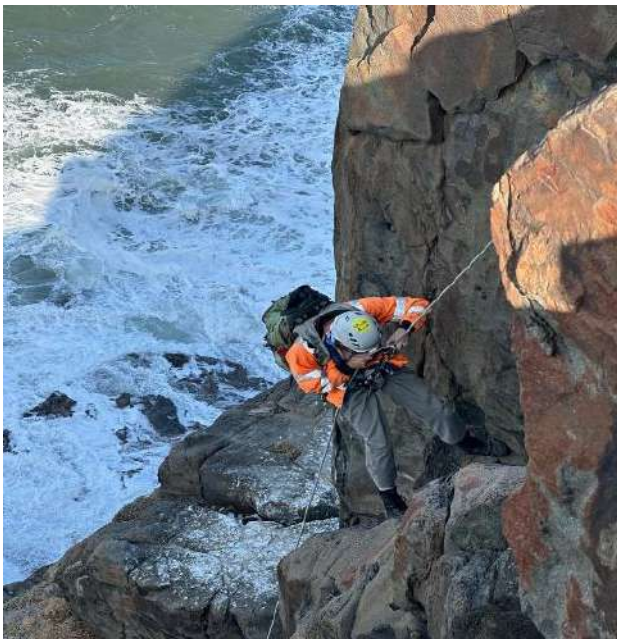

Dolphin & Whale Watching

The Morgan Bay cliffs make ideal vantage points for Dolphin and Whale watching. Dolphins are present year-round, but are more common in Winter. Southern Right and Humpback Whales can be seen far out at sea from around June to November, but only venture closer to shore when calving, so bring your binoculars. Whales and Orcas are present year-round, but sightings are quite rare.

Many good times have been enjoyed by families and friends who meet every evening in Summer for sundowners on the Morgan Bay cliffs, to reflect on the day and forget their troubles. Botha's Krantz, the furthest South of the Morgan Bay cliffs, is a great spot and the view from up top is just amazing.



Bird Watching

There is an abundance of birding habitats in Kei Mouth and Morgan Bay, ranging from the Great Kei River and Morgan Bay estuary, to back gardens, the two municipal dams, Yellowwood Forest, the beaches, Morgan Bay cliffs and coastal forest of Cape Morgan Nature Reserve. Morgan Bay has confirmed sightings of over 325 species of birds.

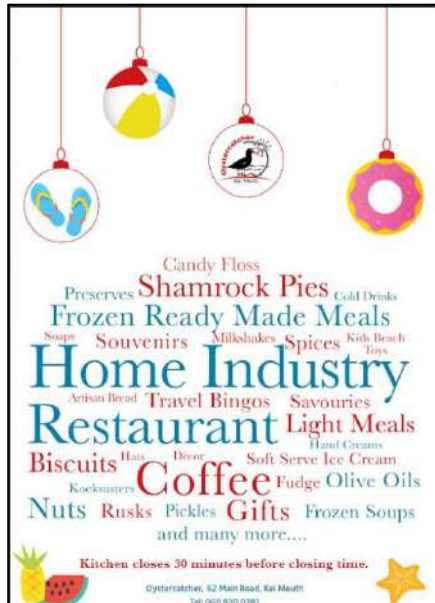

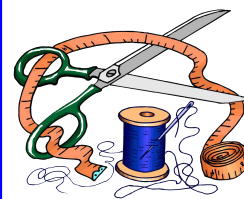

Confirmed photographic sightings of vagrant birds, which are not known to occur in Southern Africa, have been omitted from the list. These were a Buff-breasted Sandpiper (11/04/2011 - Etienne Marais), a White Tern (06/12/2018 - Etienne Marais) a Pacific Golden Plover (12/02/2020 - Frodin Saunders) and of course, the Sooty Gull which took up residence here from 01/11/2021 - 09/02/2021 (first seen by Michael Wood). All four were seen on the eastern bank of the Great Kei River.
